SAT/ACT Official Test Registration:

Register online to take the SAT and/or ACT. No one is automatically registered; you must register yourself. <u>All</u> universities in the USA accept <u>either</u> the SAT or ACT, or will take your higher score if you take both. For more information on similarities and differences between SAT and ACT, visit the websites above. SAT: \$64.50. ACT: \$67. Fee waivers available for low-income students. See a high school counselor to see if you qualify for a **fee waiver**. If you have used an SAT Fee Waiver previously, a second one is waiting in your College Board account and will automatically be applied to your next SAT. But for ACT, all waivers must come from your counselor. If you miss registration deadlines, you are subject to late fees and/or standby/waitlist fees.
