

**Notes from Parent Club  
Oct. 4, 2007**

Web site: There have been gaps in updating the school's web site, notably the ASB segment. Parents felt this should be a priority since this is our portal to the public. Sue explained that the entire site is being updated, and asked for our patience until the update is complete. She also said she'd pass our concerns onto the staff.

Homecoming: The game is Oct. 26 and the dance is Oct. 27. The theme is "Journey Through Time." Because of the inappropriate dancing that took place last year, this year's dance will have different rules. Students will receive plastic bracelets that will be removed when they are first warned about any inappropriate dancing. Then if they're warned again and have no bracelet, parents will be called and the student will have to leave the dance. Sue hopes this will solve the problem, and assured students will receive ample warning.

Fines, detentions, etc. must be dealt with before students may purchase tickets.

A suggestion was made that the crowning of the homecoming court be done during halftime so that there will be an attentive crowd. Traditionally EHS does the crowning after the game so that any players may participate. It was noted some other schools do it at halftime.

Sue's report on facilities:

Sue shared with us plans for a Learning Center in the front of the school. It will include college and career counseling and support, credit (for failed classes) recovery, and independent study facilities. She then solicited ideas from parents as to other changes/upgrades the school might want to focus on if a bond is passed to upgrade the facilities. Suggestions included: a swimming pool, more science labs, art facilities, a multi-purpose room, and updating of agriculture, PE and food service facilities.

SAT practice: The password for a free practice SAT is now being given to students. They will be able to access the testing web site and take the practice tests by next week.

College Fair: It will be held at the California Center for the Arts from 7:00 to 9:00 p.m. October 22.
